ACCENTI 2021 CONTRA COSTA COUNTY VERDELHO CALIFORNIA

Organically grown suitcase clones from the island of Madeira grow in Tom Morgan's Evina Vineyard, a sandy vineyard surrounded by nut and fruit orchards.

After Lorenza foot-tread a portion of the grapes and left them to macerate, the whole cluster-pressed juice was split into three fractions: stainless tank, stainless barrels, and neutral oak barrels. The skincontact portion was barreled down to neutral oak later.

Slow, spontaneous fermentations in the different vessels give the final blend the precise layers of a samurai sword while keeping flavors uplifting and complex.

Soft and crisp with fragrant chamomile, jasmine, oyster shell, meringue, and lemon zest."

JOHANNES ZILLINGER 2021 VELUE NIEDEROSTERREICH GRUNER VELTLINER AUSTRIA

"[VELUE = the old name of the village (Velm-Goetzendorf) and the old name of the willow trees which are growing along the small rivers in our village]

Velue, because everything what i vinify is grown in my own vineyards; bio-dynamically farmed and minimalistically vinified. Velue because I create my own individual wine style and do not force corsets on my wines. A lot of structure, perfect lightness and drinking fun characterize my Velue line."

BONNEAU 2017 SANGIACOMO VINEYARDS SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

CALIFORNIA

"The grapes for our Pinot Noir come from the prestigious Sangiacomo Vineyards that lie within the Sonoma Coast region. In the glass, this wine shows off its crystal garnet color with aromas of ripe black cherries, pomegranate, and rose petals. Well-balanced, supple tannins dance across the palate accentuating this wine's deep fruit and spices. Flavors of pomegranate, wild strawberry, cola, and clove spice follow the tannins and acidity through to the long elegant finish."

CANTINA DEL GIUSTO 2019 SAN CLAUDIO II VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO

"The Cantina Del Giusto is a small size farm situated near the foot of Montepulciano in the area of Acquaviva; it is managed by the family Del Giusto, by their three generations of winegrowers. The wines of the Cantina Del Giusto are obtained exclusively from grapes that come from their own vineyards; thanks to the limited production it is possible to concentrate on the quality without the need for force, as tradition desires, with complete respect for nature and the environment. It is thus that our wines born, fine and exceptional wines that succeed in being "innovators" thanks to the modern technology and new enological practices but at the same time "traditionalists" thanks to the centenary knowledge of agriculture and winemaking."
